

## Caregiver Core Training Training of Trainers for Child Placing Agencies

This training is designed to provide Child Placing Agencies with the following information and the opportunity to ask clarifying questions:

- High level overview of each section of the curriculum
- Information regarding field experience opportunities
- Activity and content clarification and practice run throughs as needed
- Clarification regarding specific policies and procedures
- An understanding of and agreement to maintain the integrity of the Caregiver Core Training model

You must have previously attended Caregiver Core Training in person and within the last year in order to participate in this training.

Caregiver Core Training is made up of eight sessions (each three hours long) and a field experience.

- Session 1: Introduction to the Child Welfare System
- Session 2: Working as a Member of a Team
- Session 3: Working with Birth Families
- Session 4: Cultural Connections and Advocacy
- Session 5: Growing Up with Trauma, Grief, and Loss
- Session 6: Understanding and Managing Behavior
- Session 7: Communication and Crisis Management
