

Caregiver Core Training

Training of Trainers for Child Placing Agencies

This training is designed to provide Child Placing Agencies with the following information and the opportunity to ask clarifying questions:

- High level overview of each section of the curriculum
- Information regarding field experience opportunities

- Clarification regarding specific policies and procedures
- An understanding of and agreement to maintain the integrity of the Caregiver Core Training model

You must have previously attended Caregiver Core Training in person and within the last year in order to participate in this training.

Caregiver Core Training is made up of eight sessions (each three hours long) and a field experience.

Session 3: Working with Birth Families

Session 4: Cultural Connections and Advocacy

Session 5: Growing Up with Trauma, Grief, and Loss

Session 6: Understanding and Managing Behavior

Session 7: Communication and Crisis Management

Session 8: Getting Ready and the Effects on the Caregiving Family
