4. Governor's Blue Ribbon Commission	The commission has issued its final report. WACF has endorsed the position, which calls for CA to merge with DEL and become a new department for children and families. Juvenile justice and DLR will be in the new department. Children's mental health will not.	
5. Report on progress with the Gov. Office to add Travel Time and PCV mileage to the budget.	We will not know the outcome of our advocacy efforts until the governor releases his proposed budget in mid-December.	



6. Vendor Rate Discussion Update	At the request of OFM, each division sent information about why there is a need for across the board vendor rate increases. The information sent included best guesses about lost capacity due to inadequate rates, and what improvements would occur for children and families if rates were increased.
