Guest Tim Kelly to discuss the retainer payment system	The retainer system was put in place very quickly. It is now clear some modifications are needed to handle situations when a provider sees significantly more or fewer families than the average used in setting their retainer. DCYF data show a 40% reduction in families entering the system. In March there were 20% fewer referrals to CIHS. At this point DCYF is not looking at reductions in payment to providers. The goal is to maintain the workforce. There is concern about providers who have reduced their capacity.	Members will hold a special meeting June 5 to review May data. Members are asked to bring data about how many families they served in May, how many sessions there were, and how many hours of service.
