1. Call to order and May minutes		The minutes were approved as written.
2. Current understanding of what inhome services "transformation" means to DCYF.	The DCYF plan appears to be to have "hub" agencies. It is not clear how many there would be; just one in some areas and multiple in places like King County. Families would be referred to the hub, and that agency would directly provide or contract with others to provide whatever services are needed. The CANSF would guide services.	
3. Recruitment of members from regions 1 and 2	Jill is going to Spokane this month.	

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4. Items for foundation funding	Possible items include a facilitator for meetings with DCYF, consultant or strategist to help us with readiness for performance based contracting and the "transformation", someone to do a rate study/analysis and help us make the case for a rate increase, development of contract- required trainings, help adding new EBPs if gaps identified.	No final decisions were made.
5. 2019-2020 advocacy agenda	Possible items include a rate increase and the Certificate of Parental Improvement (CPI). It is likely that changes will be made to the CPI legislation, based on problems we ran into last session.	A rate increase will be one item on our advocacy agenda. The agenda will be finalized at our July meeting.
6. Role of the divisions of WACF	This item was not discussed.	
7. Date of the July meeting	Our usual meeting time (first Thursday of the month) falls on July 4 th .	We will meet in person Thursday Jul 11, from 1PM to 3PM, at the IFD office in Federal Way. A call in option will be available.
